BIOGRAPHY of a liar like me

"It all started when I wrote these songs and made a bunch of promises I couldn't keep. I had accomplices, but they left town when the law showed up. It's no big deal. It's all about the music anyway. Just start listening...REALLY listening! Listen like all you care about is what this music can do for you and how it can change your life." - Steven Piperno

What emerged is a collection of 12 of the best songs Steven has ever written. The new album "Liar Like Me" is filled with the passion of romance, family separated by war, opera, the loss of true love, the sweet smells of childhood, growing up, finding a job, embracing change and getting lost in remembering. "Liar Like Me" just tastes good.

The record is bigger than Green To Think. Music has the power to change lives and GTT is working with the National Military Family Association to do just that. All download proceeds from "Prisoner Of War" (track 3) will be donated to the National Military Family Association (NMFA). The NMFA helps prepare spouses and children of American troops, including those who have been deployed, wounded or fallen in action, to deal with the challenges unique to military life. NMFA provides such initiatives as free camps and after-school programs that provide coping skills for children of deployed service members; spouse scholarships, and funds to help support various military community programs. How Green To Think happened

Green To Think was formed in NJ by the Piperno brothers Steven and David during the summer of 2000. With the help of a few friends they self-released their first EP titled "Fireworks On The Grass." Building off of the local success, in late 2001, long time friend (and college roommate) Ken Adessa joined as the drummer. Local musician extraordinaire Chris Smith fell in love with the unreleased track "Alison Rose" and jumped at the opportunity to employ the bass guitar. GTT was quickly courted by Fake Chapter Records to release their second EP "Sundays Were Made For This" and in May 2002 the CD was launched to a sold out crowd at Maxwell's NJ.

Good things were beginning to happen. Green To Think was broadcasted on MTV's "Made," various HBO series, several independent films including "Just Tell Me," "Getting Stiffed" and "Harlem's Beauty." They wrote music for documentaries and both cable television commercials and programs. Their CD sales climbed to over 5,000 copies as they moved out of the traditional club scene and into major festivals (NACA, Dewey, MMC), opening for Wheat, Hey Mercedes, Graham Colton and The Honorary Title during their "Eastern Seaboard Tour." (tour sponsored by Fake Chapter Records.)

After the "Eastern Seaboard tour," Green To Think went to work on their 3rd release and 1st Full Length CD. During this time, Steven's brother David decided to part ways on the best of terms. Shortly after, Ken followed suit but not before finishing most of the drums on the new record. Still with Chris Smith, Steven recruited Nick Cavagnaro (Fight Of Your Life and formerly of Darby Jones) to hit the ground running on lead guitar and Scott Pohlman (formerly of The Milwaukeees) to rock the drums. Together, they finished the record. Change has always been good to GTT and this time was no exception. "Liar Like Me" will bring more tours (Japan, Europe, LA, the Midwest, East Coast), reach more fans, and take Green To Think to a place it's never been before, and that ain't no lie.

"Liar Like Me" was written, recorded, produced and mixed by Steven Piperno, in his spare bedroom.
